This programme will interest students wishing to explore and develop their knowledge and practical experience of social and psychological issues. It also introduces students to the tenets of Psychology and Sociology as sciences while introducing the area of Youthwork.

September to May | Full-Time

Leaving Certificate or QQI Level 4 or equivalent standard of education.

All applicants must attend for interview and online assessment to determine suitability for the programme. Garda Vetting is required to complete Work Experience.
